In the fall of 2023, we asked younger and older adults living in Barry's Bay, Ontario the following questions:

WHAT DO YOU WANT PEOPLE TO REMEMBER ABOUT YOU AND YOUR LIFE? WHAT IS YOUR WISH FOR OTHERS AND THEIR LIVES?

A group of interested folks gathered twice a week for a month in February and March 2024 to reflect on these questions and explore various topics related to ageism, aging and clarifying a message to share with friends and family.
